Presenting Sponsor

\$100,000+

A gift at this level could have a significant impact on all of our programs: feeding the hungry, housing the homeless, and teaching kids and parents.

A Way Home Sponsor

\$50,000

A gift at this level could help provide thousands with food, hundreds with diapers, and dozens with secure long-term permanent housing.
