Many times families face the challenge of having to decide between paying for food or paying the rent. We don't want parents to have to make those tough decisions.

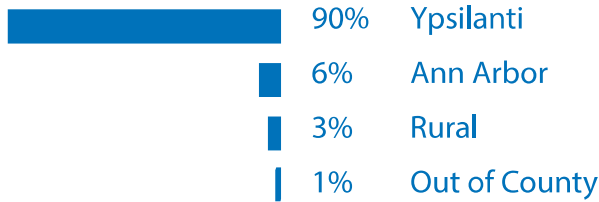
