

Parents-As-Teachers (PAT) Program



That's why SOS Community Services offers families housing and caring support to overcome the risk factors for children who are homeless or at-risk, which include developmental delays, health problems, and falling behind in school.

SOS Parents as Teachers (PAT) Program provides home visitations for families who have children age 5 or younger. Parents learn how to foster healthy growth and development for their children. PAT—a nationally recognized, research-based model program—includes parent-child play groups, individual in-home meetings with parents, developmental screenings for children, connections with community resources, and evaluations.

Poverty and homelessness put a child's development, health, and learning at risk. For any child, healthy growth and development happens in a stable, secure home.



Parents-As-Teachers (PAT) Program



This program provides support for 157 children annually who are homeless or at-risk. Families include those in SOS housing programs, and families in the community that meet the eligibility requirements.
